## VitalSight<sup>™</sup> by OMRON Healthcare

VitalSight<sup>™</sup> is the first remote patient monitoring service (RPM) from OMRON Healthcare. It is designed for hypertension management and developed to foster greater patient-to-physician connection and data sharing to improve treatment engagement and health outcomes.

- VitalSight is an easy-to-use service that enables physicians to quicky enroll patients with highrisk levels of hypertension. Patients receive an autonomous kit in their home that doesn't require WiFi or separate cellular connection. The kit includes an OMRON connected blood pressure monitor and data hub that are pre-set to securely share measurements with the patient's physician and care team.
- Patient coordinators work with patients to set up their at-home VitalSight devices and proactively reach out to them if they witness data transmission dropping off.
- VitalSight can be seamlessly integrated directly with the clinician's Electronic Medical Record (EMR) system or through the VitalSight Dashboard. VitalSight sends automatic notifications through both platforms in order to signal when a patient has readings that require action to be taken.
- VitalSight **improves access to care and greater hypertension management** for patients with limited access to in-person care. Addressing the connectivity needs of people in underserved communities and in rural areas is a key part of OMRON's mission of *Going for Zero* heart attacks and strokes.
- According to the CDC, 116 million U.S. adults Americans are hypertensive, with 37 million having uncontrolled Stage 2 hypertension with a higher risk of heart attack and stroke. OMRON developed VitalSight to help reduce that risk by providing more clinically relevant data to manage hypertension and improve patient outcomes.
- OMRON is partnering with the most forward-thinking hospital systems and independent physicians in the U.S., including Mount Sinai in New York and Northwestern Medicine in Chicago, to serve as an extension of their care teams and help streamline clinician workflow. Early feedback from physicians is showing that VitalSight is quickly helping doctors to improve patient engagement on their treatment plans.
- VitalSight is available at little or no cost to patients depending on coverage and is reimbursable through Medicare.
